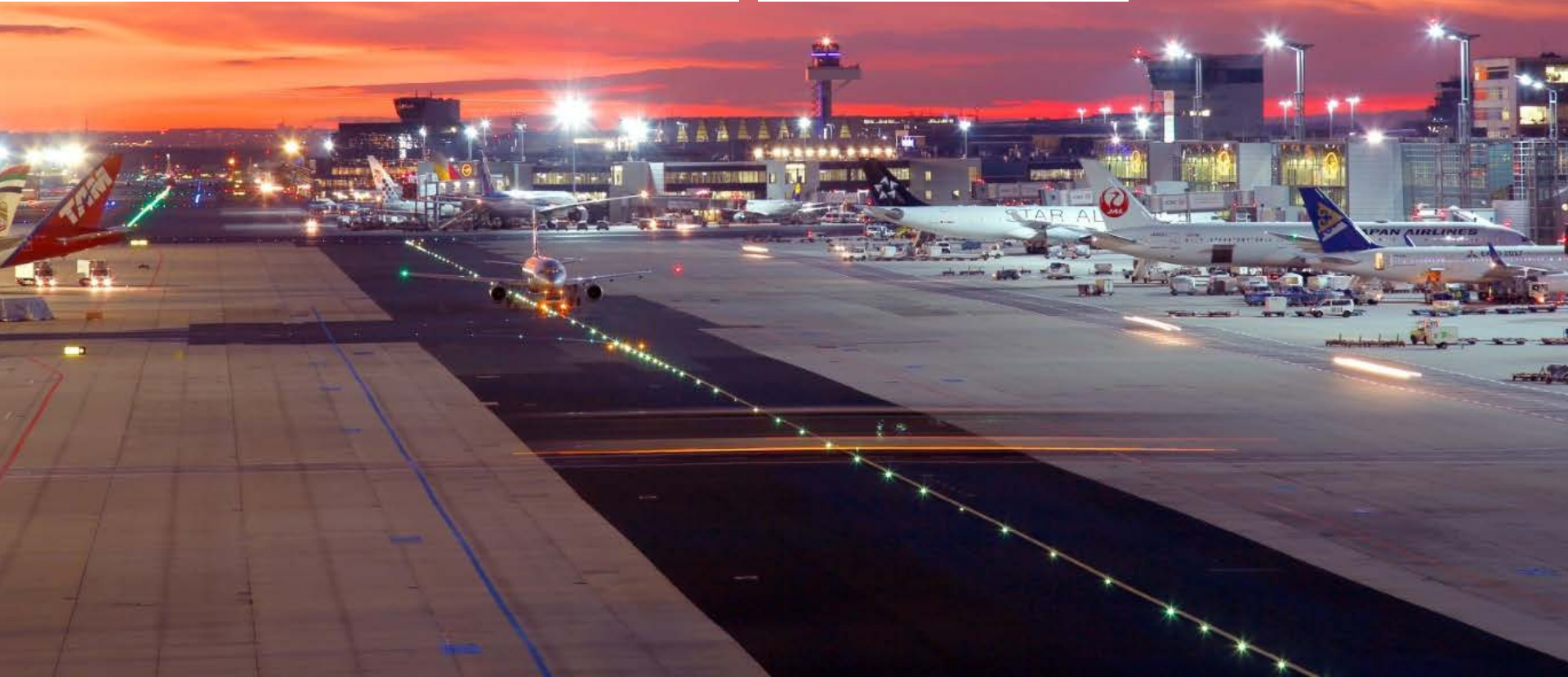

Main Challenges of the Aviation Sector Now and in Future

- Main challenge of airports (and the entire aviation sector) is to **match capacity and demand**.
- How well we succeed in matching capacity and demand determines **performance** and, of course, also **costs**.
- Physical capacity is hard to increase → **operating existing capacity efficiently is a must!**
- Can capacity in all domains (airports, TMAs and en-route sectors) be made more flexible?
- Passengers request (and deserve) **predictability** and, of course, **safety of operations**.
- Our **safety record as a sector is outstanding**; however, predictability of operations can surely be improved.
- **Improving predictability of operations** is the central topic we are working on.
- Standardization is an important issue for airports – the aviation system is a complex system and all process partners **need to pull together** in order to achieve the desired outcome!
- Reality shows that we have a **backlog of issues to be standardized**. Of utmost importance is the in-time standardization of Common Project (CP) content.
